## What's Rx Assistance?

PCHC'S Prescription Assistance Program (RxAP) helps you find ways to afford your medications. We look for low-cost or no-cost medications.

## How does it Work?

- Each pharmaceutical company has their unique application and other required documentation.
- If you qualify, you may pay a small fee or receive medication at no cost.
- Refills can be sent directly to your home, or to your provider's office for most medications.
